Frequently Asked Questions

Can my family and friends join me in the hunt?

Absolutely! Teams are fun and more successful. Here's the challenge though . . .this is a fundraiser for SAFE on Main. (www.safeonmain.org) We count on the money raised to provide our valuable services to victims of domestic violence and sexual assault, so we hope each and every adult (age 18+) donates to SAFE on Main by registering to hunt. We can't police that, so if you choose to hunt with non-registered hunters, we can't "catch" you and you aren't "cheating".

BUT . . . non-registered hunters can NOT win a hunt and they can NOT be in the hunt raffles to win a key to a treasure chest containing cash. Every individual registered hunter can submit only ONE guess per hunt using the email/name they registered with. And registered hunters can win only one of the two hunts.

With that in mind, it makes sense for EVERY adult to register. First, you're supporting a great cause and second, you can't win a key unless you are registered!

How do I register a team?

Our system allows you to register a group at the same time using one credit card if you wish. Teams that wish to pay individually may also register at the same link using separate payment methods. We do not track who is on teams, so please feel free to add registered hunters right up until November 10th at noon. Just go to www.thehuntforgood.org and find a 'Register Now!' button. Click on it, and follow the instructions within the "GiveSmart" system.

Register as many as you'd like to have on a team! The more, the merrier.

You can buy tickets for the \$500 raffle there as well. Raffle tickets are 3 for \$10.

Yes! We have a separate raffle for everyone! Non-hunters and hunters can buy raffle tickets 3 for \$10 for their chance to win \$500!

When are the two hunts and how do I win a key to a treasure chest?

Online Hunt – 3 keys awarded. The online hunt can be completed entirely from your home.

Thurs. Nov. 10th - the first clue released at 6 p.m. Hunt continues 72 hours. Ends Nov. 13th at 6 p.m.

- 1 key To first Registered Hunter (RH) who solves the online hunt, and . . .
- 2 keys All additional RHs who solve the online hunt within 72 hours (before 6 p.m. on Nov. 13, 2022) are put into Hunt 1's "Finder's Key-pers" drawing for a chance to win a key. Two will be awarded 1 key each.

Physical Hunt - 5 keys awarded This hunt requires hunters to solve clues, then go outside to search for a little box.

Fri., Nov. 11th first clue released at 4 p.m.

Sat., Nov. 12th Additional clues released early a.m. Hunt till 5 p.m.

3 keys to the first RH who finds the physical hunt box, and . . .

2 keys Ten additional RHs who find the box before Sat. Nov. 12th at 5 p.m. are put into Hunt 2's "Finder's Key-pers" drawing for a chance to win a key. Two hunters will receive one key each.

When and how are the keys awarded?

On November 15th at 5pm at SAFE on Main (420 East Main Street, Lebanon Ohio 45036) there will be a "Treasure Chest Opening Event". Key winners will be invited to attend in person to see how much their key is worth. Winners may also attend remotely as well.

This event will also be streamed on Facebook live.

Is the treasure hunt over once the hidden item is found for the online hunt and when the little box is found in the physical hunt?

NO – even if you're NOT first place, you can still win keys.

The online hunt takes places over the course of three days (72 hours). The first registered hunter to identify the hidden item wins 2 keys, but the hunt is NOT over! Two more keys will be awarded to successful online hunters via a "Finder's Key-pers" drawing, so KEEP working at solving the clues, identify the hidden item, then email your guess before the 72 hours are up!

In the physical hunt, the first registered hunter who finds the little box wins three keys, but the next ten successful registered hunters are placed in a second "Finder's Key-pers" drawing for a chance to win a key. You don't have to be first to win!

Is The Hunt For Good suitable for children?

Children age 12 and over with an interest and aptitude for puzzle solving and online research would enjoy participating with a parent or teacher. Please note that registered hunters must be 18+ years or older, so an adult must register in order for minors to hunt. Minors cannot be awarded cash. There's a \$500 raffle for adults who don't want to hunt.

How do I get the clues?

Clues are emailed directly to registered hunters when the event begins, then throughout the hunt. After you register, you will receive a welcome email that explains details.

How hard are the clues?

The creation and testing of the clues is a two-person labor of love. The clues are similar to those created the first year (2021), and although hunters found them challenging, they agreed that the clues were fun and doable.

The mini-hunt at www.thehuntforgood.org is a way to practice and sharpen your skills. Give that a try!

Teams were especially successful, because teams have people with a variety of skills and experience. So, team-up!

I hate thinking that I might work on a clue, then never know if I got the right answer, or how close I got to the answer....

We don't like that either, so all registered hunters will be provided with a breakdown of the clue solutions after the event is over.

Can you give us a general idea of where the physical hunt will take place?

The physical hunt's container is hidden in a publicly accessible location in Warren County, Ohio.

Do I have to live in Warren County, Ohio to participate and/or win?

Nope. Read the Official Rules for details, but generally, any adult U.S. citizen living anywhere can register, hunt, and win. Hunt 1 is all online, so that makes it possible to hunt from anywhere. Hunt 2

requires actual physical hunting, so that one requires hunters to be physically IN Warren County during the hunt.

How do I win cash?

There are three possible ways to win cash:

- An Online Hunt, a Physical Hunt, and the \$500 Raffle.

If I win a key do get a cash award?

YES! Every key holder wins' cash. Eight keys will be awarded to six individuals. The hunt cash awards will be in:

Three separate treasure chests:

One containing \$2,500	1 key opens & winner gets: \$2,500
A second containing \$500	2 keys open – two \$500 winners
The third containing \$200	5 keys open – five \$200 winners

TOTAL awarded to Hunters holding keys: \$4,500

PLUS there's a \$500 raffle!

How is SAFE on Main able to give away \$5,000 in cash?

Generous sponsors are donating to our cause and we encourage you to review the list of their logos and thank them for their support! We also hope we get more than 200 registered hunters,

so we can MAKE money to support our work. This is why we hope that if you hunt in a team and that everyone registers.
